Eight Extraordinary New Miami Real-Estate Developments [SLIDESHOW]

If the old adage “Location, location, location” really is the No. 1 priority in real estate, then the Surf Club Four Seasons is poised for success. Stationed on 9 oceanfront acres in Miami Beach, the residence includes two 12-story towers comprising 150 homes, two restaurants, four swimming pools, a fitness center and spa, and beautiful seaside gardens. Ranging in size from 1,400 to nearly 8,000-square-foot, the two- to five-bedroom residences feature en suite bathrooms, floor-to-ceiling windows, and large terraces with frameless glass balcony railings. Architect Richard Meier teamed up with designer Lee Mindel to conceive the residences’ gorgeous interiors, which boast custom-designed kitchens with lacquered cabinets, Miele and Sub-Zero appliances, and Corian countertops. For those looking for something extra fancy, the penthouses include rooftop gardens, private swimming pools, outdoor dining areas, courtyards, summer kitchens, beachfront cabanas, and air-conditioned private parking garages.
